Thank you for being so patient while waiting for these maps showing your locations for the 2026 RLE Country Faire. Remember, **The Faire is at the Dry Creek Ranch house 6852 Dry Creek Rd. RL You can come as early as 5 AM, bring a flashlight if you come before 6. You can enter by the bridge, DRIVE SLOW!**

Please feel free to share the flyer and maps on your social media, email, wherever you would like. WE NEED YOU TO ADVERTISE ALSO, INVITE EVERYONE!!!!!!!

I would like to ask you to leave the small stake/sign at the front center of your space. The reason why, when customers walk by but want to go back to your booth, they will remember the number, or take a pic of the booth number. You are welcome to take the signs with you when you take down.

PLEASE BRING YOUR RAFFLE ITEM TO THE RAFFLE BOOTH #148, BY 10 AM. ONCE WE RECEIVE YOUR ITEM, WE WILL MARK YOU OFF ON THE RAFFLE SHEET. (Craft Vendors Only)

FOOD TRUCKS- PLEASE ARRIVE BETWEEN 8AM to 10AM – see maps of where to park.

Please do not plan to visit your space or start set-up before 3 p.m. on Friday Sept 18th, 2026. That's because we may not be finished with marking and staking all the spaces.

You are welcome to set-up your canopy and tables after 3 p.m. on Friday. Many of you have asked about security. We do NOT have any security overnight on Friday. There will be 3 RVs staying overnight but please do not think of this as security. We are also having some vendors stay overnight both nights. You are allowed to camp out! We haven't had any trouble with vendors leaving their canopy, tables and chairs overnight. But I would not advise leaving anything valuable that you cannot easily replace should it disappear. **Please plan to have your booth set up and staffed no later than 8:00 a.m. on Saturday morning.**

Please plan to off-load and remove your vehicle as quickly as possible to the Vendor Parking area. DO NOT SET UP YOUR BOOTH UNTIL YOUR CAR IS MOVED TO VENDOR PARKING!!

Everyone needs to move their vehicles IMMEDIATELY so that others can pull up and unload also.

After you have unloaded and parked you can finish setting up your booth. There are over 150 vendors so plan accordingly. Bringing a wagon or cart to move your equipment is a wise idea. There will not be room for everyone to park near their location to unload. You can drive on the grass slowly, unload then move your vehicle ASAP

After 4 pm, you can pack up. Please leave your space clean, we don't have time to clean up after you. If you leave a mess, we have the right to bill you a fee, and we will.
